(SSA/RRB Withhold)**

By completing this form, you are requesting to have your SummaCare plan premium automatically deducted from your monthly Social Security (SSA) or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) check. **To ensure the best opportunity for approval, the request may be submitted for a future effective date of up to 90 days from the date of receipt.** After your premium withhold form is processed, you will be notified of the effective date that your deduction is scheduled to begin. Until then, please continue to pay your plan premium. Generally, you must stay with the same premium payment option you choose for the rest of the year.
